AND MISS REARDON DRINKS A LITTLE, (by the author of Man In the Moon Marigolds) is the first production of the 1973-74 subscription season. To follow are LULU, (PANDORA'S BOX), a new adaptation of two plays by Frank Wedekind, the prophet of sexuality in modern theatre; December 7, 8, 13, 14, 15.; AMPHYTRION 38, a spritely comedy by Jean Giraudoux on March 1, 2, 7, 8, 9; THE EMPIRE BUILDERS, a theatrically provocative modern drama by Boris Vian, April 19, 20, 25, 26, 27, and SUSANNAH, an area premier of the American opera by Carlisle Floyd on May 17, 18, 22, 23, 24, 25. Season tickets (entitling the holder to attend a variety of additional presentations) are still available at a savings.

The first Youth Theatre production this year will be Aurand Harris' version of ANDROCLES AND THE LION, which will be given six performances on November 15,16,17, in the University Theatre.

Additions to the Drama faculty this year include Scene Designer Donamarie Reeds, Costume Designer Lee Livingstone and Director Patricia Madsen. Frank McCann has returned to our Radio-Television area from ITV. PLAYERS, The Drama Department Honorary serves coffee at intermissions. Donations are contributed to the Hugh Gillis Scholarship Fund.

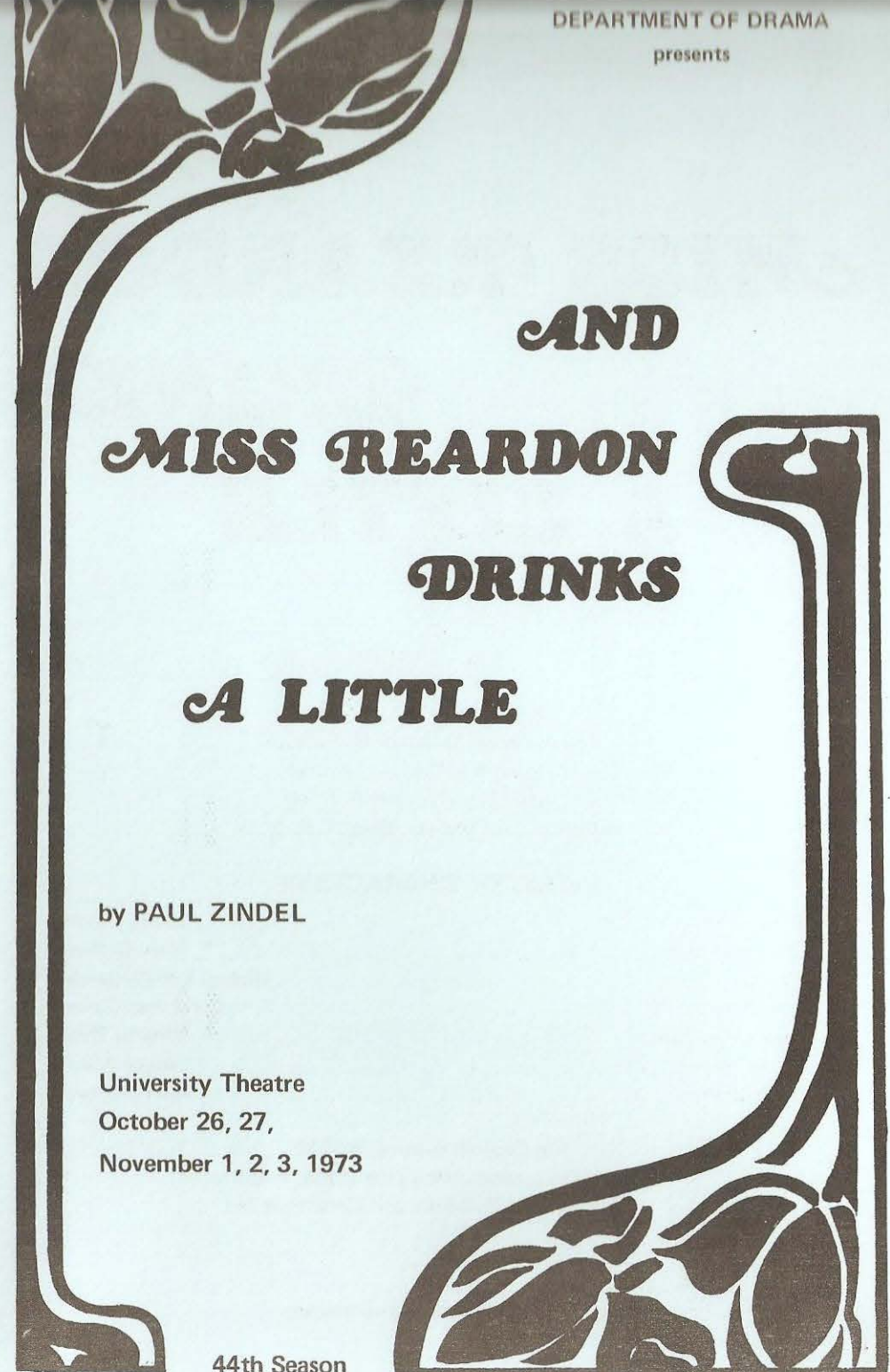
