Scope and Content of Collection

Volume/Portfolio 2, is comprised of seventeen (07-23) oversized black and white mounted photographs depicting a range of early Italian religious sculptures and reliefs, found in various repositories in Florence, Italy that between the 15th and 16th centuries. Within this Volume, most of the artists of the photographed artifacts are identified. The list of artists includes such renowned figures as Luca della Robbia, Andrea della Robbia, Giovanni della Robbia, Antonio Rossellino, Andrea del Verrocchio, and Michaelangelo Buonarroti. Celebrated works include Luca della Robbia's "Madonna of the Apple" and Michaelangelo's "Pieta." Stone identified the negative number and art style and the period on the verso of each print.

Volume 3/Portolios 3-6 (24-95): Photographic Images of Early Italian Paintings, 1941

Scope and Content of Collection

Volume 3 consists of portfolios 3-6, with seventy-two (prints 24-95) oversized black and white mounted photographs depicting a range of early Italian religious paintings, found in various repositories in Florence, Italy between the 13th and 16th centuries. Within this series, most creators of the photographed artifacts are identified. The list of artists in portfolio 3 (prints 024-041) include such renowned figures as Mariotto Albertinelli, Fra Angelico, Zanobi di Benedetto Strozzi, Alesso Baldovinetti, Sandro Botticelli, and Michaelangelo Buonarroti; in portfolio 4 (prints 042-060), Carlo Cignani, Cimabue, Correggio, Lorenzo di Credi, Buoninsegna di Duccio, Fabriano da Gentile, Domenico Ghirlandaio, Giotto di Bondone, Francesco Granacci, Leonardo da Vinci, Filippo Lippi, and Michaelangelo Buonarroti; in portfolio 5 (prints 061-078), Filippo Lippi, Lorenzo Monaco, Pietro Lorenzetti, Lippo Memmi, Simone Martini, Masaccio, Parmigianino, Cosimo di Piero, and Perugino; in portfolio 6 (prints 069-095), Rafael, Rosso Fiorentino, Andrea del Sarto, Sassoferrato, Luca Signoerlli, Sodoma, Veneziano Domenico, and Veronese. The images include depictions of panel paintings, works of tempera and gold leaf, oil on wood, alterpeices, and shrines. Among this series' most celebrated works are Strozzi's "Madonna of the Star", Sarto's Madonna of the Harpies, and Botticelli's Madonna of the Pomegranate. Stone identified the negative number and art style and the period on the verso of each print.
