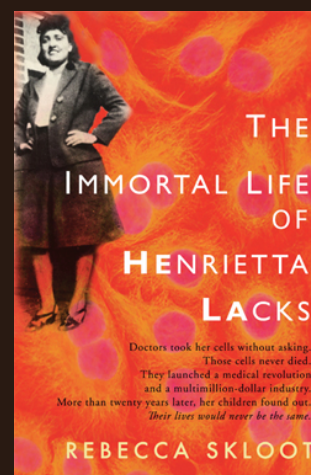

Brandon White is an Assistant Professor in Biological Sciences at SJSU, teaching courses in molecular biology, molecular biological techniques, and cell biology. His research focuses on Notch signaling and identification, and characterization of natural products involved in cell death of cancer cells. In addition to maintaining a student research lab on campus, White helped develop a program to train students interested in working in hospital and biotechnology settings in the area of molecular diagnostics in human diseases.
