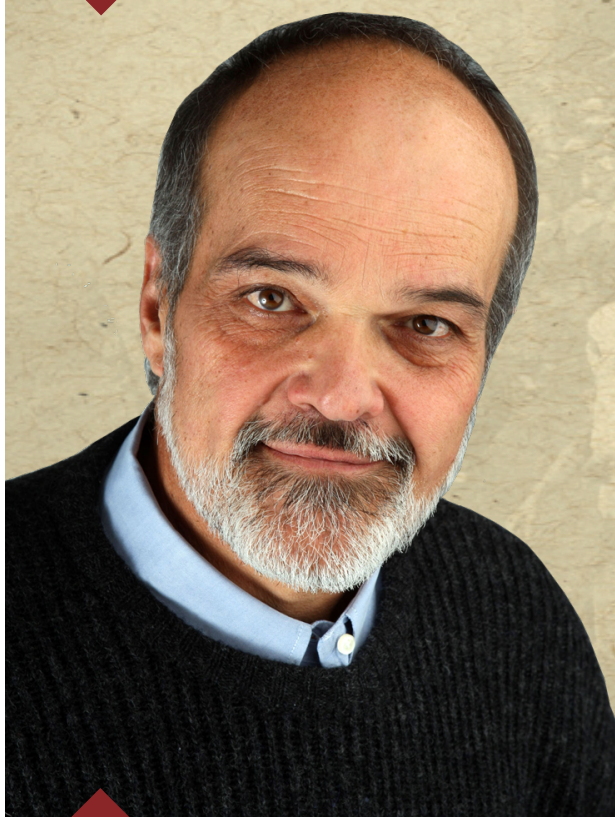

Come hear Pulitzer Prize-winning photojournalist Kim Komenich talk about his current project, "Revolution Revisited".

SJSU Assistant Professor Kim Komenich worked for 30 years as a photojournalist for the *San Francisco Chronicle* and *San Francisco Examiner*. He was awarded the 1987 Pulitzer Prize in Spot News Photography for photographs of the Philippine Revolution he made while on assignment for the *Examiner*. Komenich's current creative project, "Revolution Revisited", is a 25th Anniversary look back at the 1986 Philippine "People Power" Revolution. In 2012, he will publish the book, *Revolution Revisited*, and a full-length documentary film by the same name.
